



Curriculum Development Expectations-Small Animal Management

- Applicants will be expected to meet in person at the designated location for both meetings
 - October 14th and November 4th in Austin, Texas
- Teachers will also be paid mileage if traveling in a personal vehicle.
- Housing and meals will be provided for the teachers
- Teacher writers will receive a stipend of \$500 for the development of the curriculum*
- Teachers will work in teams to evaluate current curriculum available, develop lesson plans and supportive lesson activities.
- Teachers will complete the lessons using a standard template for the lesson plan as well as provide as many documents that teachers can use in the classroom
- The end result will be to provide all teachers with valuable lessons to use in the classroom.
- The developed curriculum will be placed on the ATAT Curriculum website for all members free of cost
